WHY BOOK AN ENGAGEMENT SESSION

Engagement photos will help you look back at this wonderful time of excitement, promise, and happiness. These portraits will always be special.

Aside from the wedding day photos, these photographs are very meaningful. They showcase the couples' love for each other and can be used for "Save the Dates", wedding decor, wedding websites, invitations, centerpieces, and other things related to showers and the big day.

It's your time to simply focus on what the two of mean to each other, and to create portraits that show how you began your walk together thu life as an engaged couple.

W H A T **TO EXPECT**

My goal with each session is to make things as seamlessas possible for you. I believe that when you hire a photographer, it should be someone who you feel comfortable with - so that is what I strive for. I like to spend some time communicating with you about what you have in mind before the shoot. We can discuss props, clothing, and locations. I have a Pinterest page if you would like to share ideas.

- How long will it take? Most sessions last 1-2 hours.
- When will I get my photos? It usually takes 1 2 weeks to go thru all the photos, edit and post them.
- Can we meet in person? Yes. If you would like, we can meet at a local coffee shop or other venue to discuss what you have in mind. I enjoy hearing about you as a couple and your story. This is a great way to learn about your style and come up with some initial ideas. If you would rather not meet in person, we can communicate thru email or telephone calls.

MY STYLE RELAXED PORTRAITURE

If you are reading this Welcome Guide, chances are you have already had an opportunity to view the work on my website. As a photographer, I absolutely love capturing images that are fresh, clean, and timeless.

I consider my style to be 'relaxed portraiture' - in the sense that it is much more casual than some more traditional portrait photographers. If my style of photography is what your are looking for, then I just might be the photographer for your engagement session!



W H A T

- Comfort First, it is important to be comfortable! If you are in pain because of the 5-inch stiletto shoes you are wearing, you are not going to have a relaxed smile!
- Simple Basically, simple is best. Large bold patterns and neon colors tend to take the focus away from the people in the photo and draw your eye toward the clothing. Choose shirts that don't have words on them. (unless you are going for the super hero theme, or wearing team shirts)
- Theme Some couples like to choose a theme that shows a bit of their personality. Perhaps a plaid shirt and jeans for the farming family, a favorite team jersey, or cowboy hats and boots.
- Matching Couples should be sure that the colors and styles complement each other. (formal dress vs jeans and t-shirt)
- Location Make sure that your clothing will look appropriate at your chosen location.
- Lips and Nails If you are someone who enjoys makeup, you may want to have your lipstick or gloss handy for touch ups. A fresh coat of nail polish in a neutral color that won't distract or clash with your outfits will help you look polished.
- Glasses If you want to wear your glasses in the photos, it might be best to remove the lenses so there are no reflective spots. Be aware that transition lenses will appear dark if worn outdoors.

Note: Please let me know if you are planning to bring more than one outfit. It is important to let me know what you are thinking so we can plan our time together.



W H E N TO BOOK

Some clients prefer to have their engagement photos done a few months before their wedding. Other couples choose to have them taken just after their engagement. I have found it is best to snap them whenever you can be the most relaxed!

My schedule is typically full months in advance, so please get in touch with me as soon as possible to book me as your engagement session photographer!

LOCATION WHERE TO GO

If your favorite thing to do is have a picnic in the park, then that's where we should go! If you love champagne, dressing up and a high class background, that's the way to go. If you both enjoy reading, a library may be the place for you! Ask yourselves what things do you like to do together. What makes you feel connected?

It is also a good idea to think about your history as a couple. If you met at a coffee shop, I can shoot over a cup of coffee. Some couples like to go back to the place where they got engaged. That place will always have special meaning, and could show part of your story in the photos.

Incorporating hobbies is another way to make your shoot personal. Riding horses, biking, camping, picking berries, visiting an antique market, or going to a ball field would show a bit of your personalities.

Note: I do need to charge extra for traveling distances that are not in the local Lancaster area.

PROPS & SUCH

Adding props to photos is one of my favorite ways to help show personality! Chalk boards and other items to display your wedding date are popular, especially for "Save the Date" photos. Perhaps fashion props like hats or shoes would be your style.

If you have a pet*, we can incorporate them into a few photos. After all, they will be part of your new family.

You can also bring along anything that might have special meaning to you. Perhaps a family quilt, a special chair or stool, or jewelry that belonged to grandma.

I have a few props that I can bring along. This is part of what we will discuss before your photo shoot.

*Note about animals. I have found that if there is a pet involved, it is best to bring an extra person along on the shoot that the animal knows to help get the pet to look toward the camera!



Y O U R INVESTMENT

My Session Fee Includes:

- Time and talent of the photographer
- On-site photography session
- Editing of all images
- Private online photo gallery



You may be wondering why my session fees are so much lower than many other photographers. I don't have any "packages" that are included in the session fee. I like to let my clients order just the specific photos they actually want to help keep the costs down. I don't promise a certain number of images in your gallery. I will post all of the photos that I feel turned out well.

I use a professional printing service that creates excellent prints. They are much nicer than what you could purchase online, or get printed from files. They are reasonably priced (5x7 = 9.99), and are mailed directly to whoever purchases them in professional mailers. You can also download digital files. They are priced according to file size. A LowRes 1 Mpix, suitable for online sharing, is 14.99. A HighRes 4 Mpix, suitable for 8x10 prints, is 29.99. In most cases, it is more cost efficient to order the high quality prints online. We use the full size file for printing, which may be larger than the 4 Mpix. Our prints are high-quality professional prints, and will last for many years.

There are also other products available on the website like keepsake boxes, mugs, key tags, cards, phone cases etc.

You can share the web address and password for the online gallery with any friends and family who might enjoy seeing or ordering their own photos. I can remove any photos that you don't like before you share the link. Many of my clients enjoy that option because it saves them time collecting money and photo orders of who wants what, and then delivering the photos!

*Note: A nonrefundable retainer fee is required to complete the booking process. Please contact me if you have any questions.



H ○ W TO BOOK

Ready to book your engagement photography experience with me? Here are your next steps:

- 1) DATE: Get in touch with me and let me know what time of year you would like to shoot your photos. I can let you know what dates I have available. Saturdays tend to book up very fast. I don't work on Sundays.
- 2) RETAINER: I ask that all of my clients pay a nonrefundable retainer fee in order to complete the booking process. I will send you some paperwork to complete and return along with your retainer, and then you will be officially booked!
